Council Member \_\_\_\_\_ introduced the following Resolution entitled **“RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD, IOWA AMENDING THE MARCH 1, 2018-01 RESOLUTION FOR COURTHOUSE SQUARE/STREET SCAPE RE-DEVELOPMENT OPTIONS”**, and moved that the same be adopted. Following special meetings held on March 1, 2018 and March 6, 2018 and pursuant to prior City of Bloomfield Resolution Number 2017-02, adopted May 18, 2017, and the prior Public Hearing and notice that was provided in connection therewith, further hearing before the City Council of Bloomfield, Iowa was held on March 8, 2018 on the request to approve revised plans to remove certain parts of the project from the scope of the original project for the Courthouse Square/Street Scape Re-Development Option as set forth in Exhibit A.

No written objections were made or filed with the City Clerk and public discussion was held. Upon completion of the Hearing, the following Resolution of the City of Bloomfield, Iowa, City Council was adopted by unanimous vote of the City Council of the City of Bloomfield, Iowa.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bloomfield, Iowa voted 3-2 in favor of approving the plan as set forth in Exhibit A which removes any sidewalk installation on the courtyard property, removes any installation of underground drain pipes to alleviate the rooftop runoff from the courthouse, and removes the installation of a handicapped accessible ramp leading to the courthouse basement;

AND WHEREAS, Bloomfield Alderman Earl Howard, voting in the majority during the March 1, 2018 Courthouse Square/Street Scape Development Plan, now wishes to amend said plan;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the city of Bloomfield, Iowa, the proposed plans and terms set forth for the Courthouse Square/Street Scape Re-Development in Exhibit A are hereby approved with the following amendment:

(1) The City acknowledges to Davis County that the new street improvements occurring on the County's property around the courtyard on Franklin, Madison and Jefferson Streets according the plan in Exhibit A, will be maintained by the City of Bloomfield.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bloomfield, Iowa, that the Mayor of the City of Bloomfield, is hereby authorized and directed to complete such documents, as may be necessary to carry forth the purpose and intent of this Resolution.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon approval by the City Council and execution by the Mayor.
