Please find attached our 2025 Application for the allocation of the Hotel-Motel Tax monies.

Our rationale is as follows:

- Davis County Tourism is the only non-profit organization to advertise and promote tourism to the entire county, state, and nation through regional, state, area and local advertising. We purchase locally whenever possible, but are looking to expand advertising opportunities in other media beyond traditional print media.
- Our Welcome Center is operated and run exclusively by unpaid volunteers and is **open year-round**. **In 2024, our volunteers logged 1,653 hours at the Welcome Center** in addition to serving at local events such as book-signings, our fair booth, and fundraisers. We welcomed **close to 2,000 visitors at** the Welcome Center in 2024.
- Two major bus tours to Davis County in 2024 netted the community over \$6,000 in food and lodging alone. These figures do not include additional purchases by visitors, including local goods. The Corporation itself does not receive any direct money from these visits nor from the State of Iowa.
- Our website is available 24/7 and serves as a reference point to over 1,000 people a
 month from around the world. We list, free of charge, local businesses, churches,
 historical information about the county, an event calendar, recreational opportunities and
 other pertinent information to potential visitors to Davis County. We also publish
 information about news, events, merchants, and the community through Facebook,
 Instagram, and YouTube, table toppers at local establishments, and postings at the
 Welcome Center and outdoor message boards as well.
- In 2024, we expanded our activities to include hosting two book-signings and a presentation by the author of the 29th State, all of which were very well-attended. We have also worked hard to coordinate with other local entities such as the Library and the Historical Society. All of these events were free and open to the public.
- In 2025, with enough funding, we will have the opportunity to expand the public offerings for events, to include the author of Notes on Iowa, Historian Dr. Kevin Mason. We also could take advantage of professional photographer and author of Iowa Road Trip, Brian Abeling, who would come to Davis County to photograph sites of interest

around the county. This package would include an archive of 40 professional photographs for Davis County to use in promotions, as well as having those locations highlighted on the Web and Facebook to an audience across the United States.

- Our membership dues and additional fund-raising activities account for just a fraction of
 what it costs to maintain the Welcome Center and also to promote the county locally as
 well as the public at large.
- Davis County Tourism and the Welcome Center serve all of Davis County as well as our actual and potential visitors.

Therefore, the allocation of Hotel-Motel funding, which all of our work helps to attract, is vital to our continuing success at promoting Davis County.

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Hotel/Motel Funding Request Information

One of our current transformation strategies with Main Street America is called Knowledge Economy. In 2024 we used these funds to market our program, educate business owners, advertise our events to bring in more members of the community, and print Experience Bloomfield Brochures.

As we continue to work on this strategy in 2025 we plan to do some of the same things we did in 2024 but we need to concentrate on reaching consumers in the surrounding counties and beyond. There is a noticeable gap in the amount of people who know about events and businesses in our community that only live 30-45 minutes away. We want to be able to continue to support local media but also utilize resources in other communities as well.

There is an educational component to this as well. Helping business owners learn how to market their business and reach different demographics is a very important part of the tourism aspect as people won't visit a community if they think there's nothing there to see. Last year we had several speakers that came in to help businesses with creating graphics and updating google listings but we need to dive deeper.

We have started getting in some marketing merchandise and plan to continue adding to the collection. Being able to get our name and community information out there is a key component to getting people to stop here or attend our events.
