Tomi Jo and Kyle:

Here are the key items in terms of City responsibility:

The City's obligations are for: storm sewer and drainage infrastructure; utility-related pavement repairs; snow windrows and areas outside DOT traffic lanes; sidewalks and pedestrian infrastructure; tree removal and trimming; and traffic signals and street lighting.

The City is responsible for repairs to pavement caused by utility construction, maintenance, and repair. The City should confirm that its utility-permit process, franchise agreements, and right-of-way policies allow the City to recover costs from utilities or require restoration to City/DOT standards where appropriate.

The DOT plows traffic lanes, but the City must remove windrowed snow and snow/ice outside traffic lanes. This would appear to be an issue only on the square.

I see no issue with signing the agreement.
