WHEREAS, Tomi Jo Day is engaged as Finance Manager of the City of Bloomfield; and

WHEREAS, Andrew Morris has resigned as the City Administrator of the City of Bloomfield effective September 18, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is interested in avoiding the cost and time of going through a search process for an Interim City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, Tomi Jo Day is willing to take on added responsibilities and to serve as Interim City Administrator subject to City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to appoint Tomi Jo Day as the Interim City Administrator, with the understanding that her duties as Interim City Administrator will commence on September 19, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Day and the Council have discussed an increase in Day’s compensation to an amount equal to \$65,000 on an annualized basis and the Council finds that salary to be appropriate. The remaining benefits will be consistent with the terms of the Employee Handbook of the City of Bloomfield.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council hereby authorizes the appointment of Tomi Jo Day as the Interim City Administrator at a salary of \$65,000 per year.
