Good Morning Aaron,

This email is being sent as a follow up to our phone conversation.

The Bloomfield City Council decided at their last Council Meeting held Thursday May 6, 2021 to close the existing tree dump indefinitely. On Friday May 7, 2021 the tree dump was closed by placing concrete barricades across the entrance and changing the signage to TREE DUMP CLOSED.

There is an easement through this parcel held by an Amish family. We have placed the barriers in such a manner to allow the Amish buggies to pass through but prevent auto traffic.

The City will be investigating future steps and costs associated with these steps. I will include your office with any updates on further actions that the City Council may take.
