

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF BLOOMFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 24
(HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD, IOWA:

Section 1. The City of Bloomfield Municipal Code (the "Code") Chapter 24, Section 24.03(1), is hereby amended as follows (Note: provisions deleted from the Code are struck through and provisions added to the Code are underlined):

24.03 COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP.

1. The Historic Preservation Commission (hereinafter referred to as the Preservation Commission or Commission) consists of ~~seven~~five members appointed by the Council. The members of the Preservation Commission shall be residents of the City or owners of real property within the City. At least one resident (or property owner within the district who is also a resident of the City) of each designated area of historic significance shall be appointed to the Commission. Members shall receive no compensation. The members shall have a demonstrated interest in historic preservation and, as available, shall include professionals in history, architectural history, archaeology, planning, or architecture.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any section, provisions, or parts of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
