The Bloomfield City Council met in a special session at 7:00pm at the Bloomfield Public Library while also utilizing Google Meets to allow the public a way to attend the meeting. The following Council members were present:

Mayor Pro Tem Garrett called the meeting to order and welcomed those present.

Everyone stood and recited the pledge of allegiance.

Public Comments

- Chris Ball - Judy Dorman resigned as executive director of Main Street. We need to figure out the next steps for the organization. In order to maintain the accreditation through Main Street Iowa, the executive director must maintain a minimum of 25 hours/week in the office.

Mayor Pro Tem Garrett announced this is the time and place fixed for a Public Hearing for the purpose of approving the maximum tax levy for the FY2022 budget.

Mayor Pro Tem Garrett attended a Regional Service Agency meeting regarding the regional contract with Waste Management. Bloomfield is fortunate. Most communities are being charged over \$22 for their monthly service. Bloomfield is much lower than that. Beginning with the new contract, residents will not be allowed to place a large item on the curb for pickup. Instead, residents will be given a punch card to take out to the rural facility on Karr Street. Also new with this contract is that each household will be given an account number by Waste Management. Residents will need this account number to call Waste Management themselves for complaints/problems.
