Citizen Questionnaire City of Bloomfield, Iowa

The City of Bloomfield is developing a plan to improve the sanitary sewer system in hopes to lower the amount of clean water being treated at the wastewater treatment plant and keep operating costs as low as possible. During a single rainfall event, over 2.5 million gallons of clean water (rainfall, snowmelt, runoff) enters the City's sewer system. This additional volume of water is then treated at the wastewater treatment plant, causing operating costs to increase significantly. Sewer operating costs are ultimately paid by residents via sewer user fees – so the less water to treat, the lower the sewer user fees.

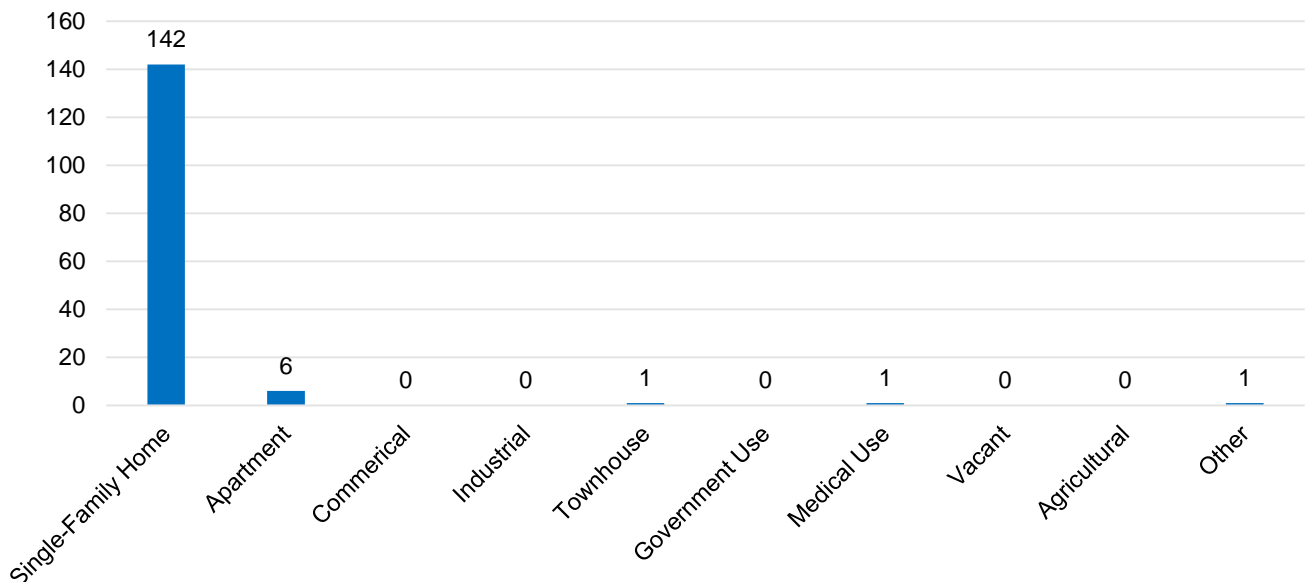

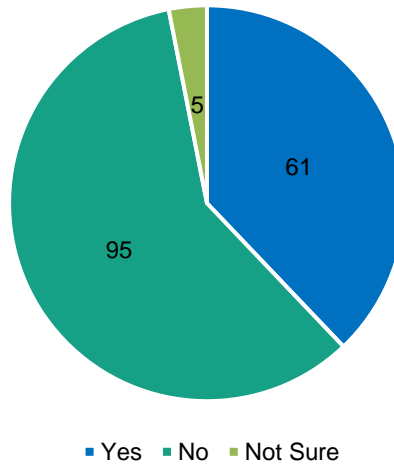

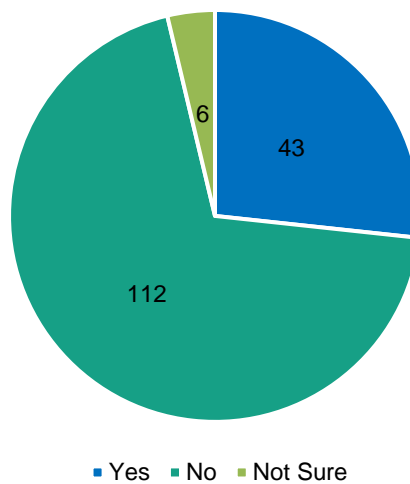

Sewer Backups

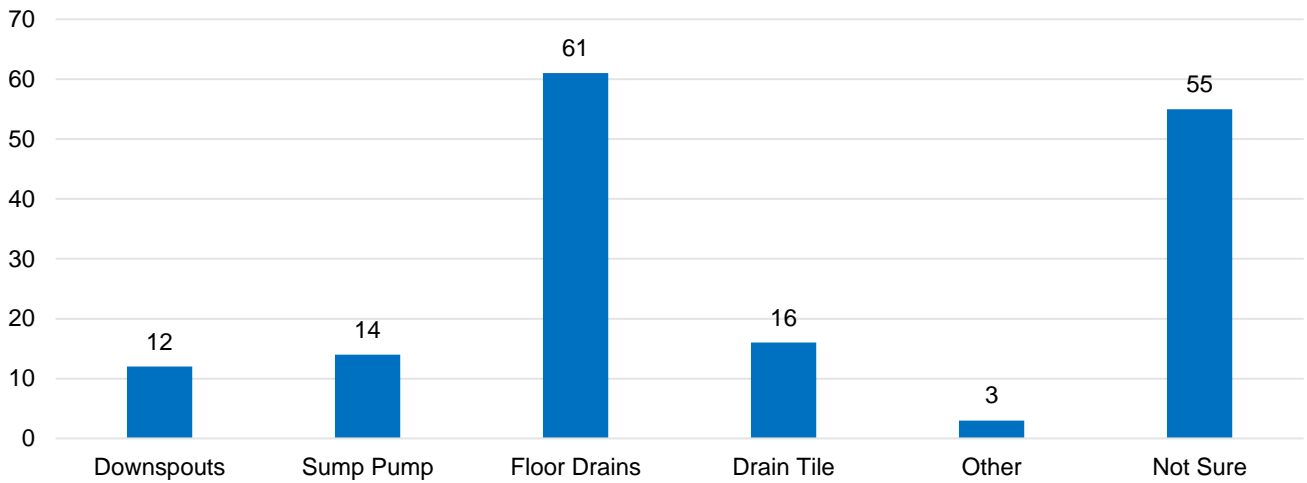

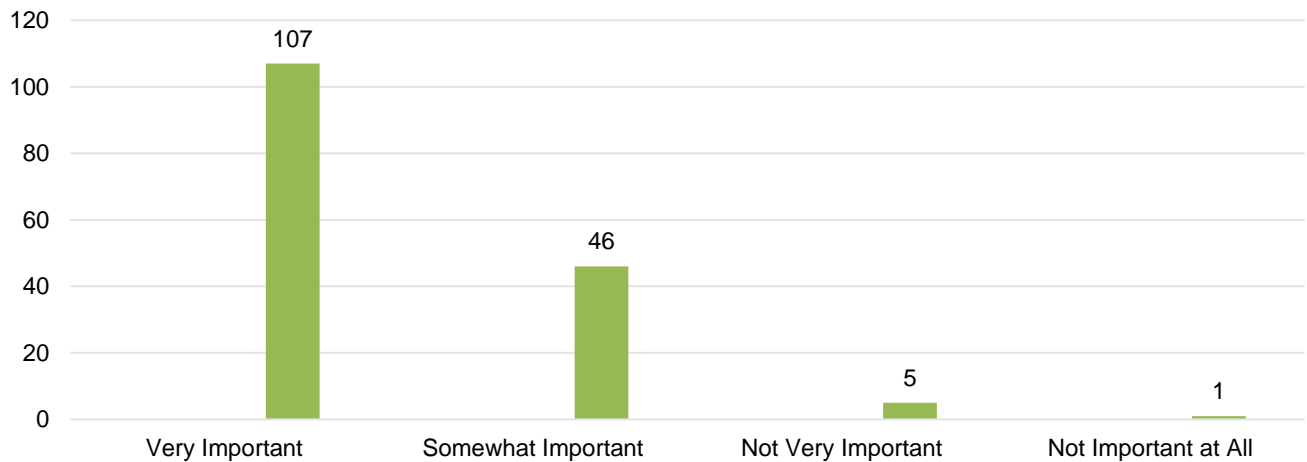

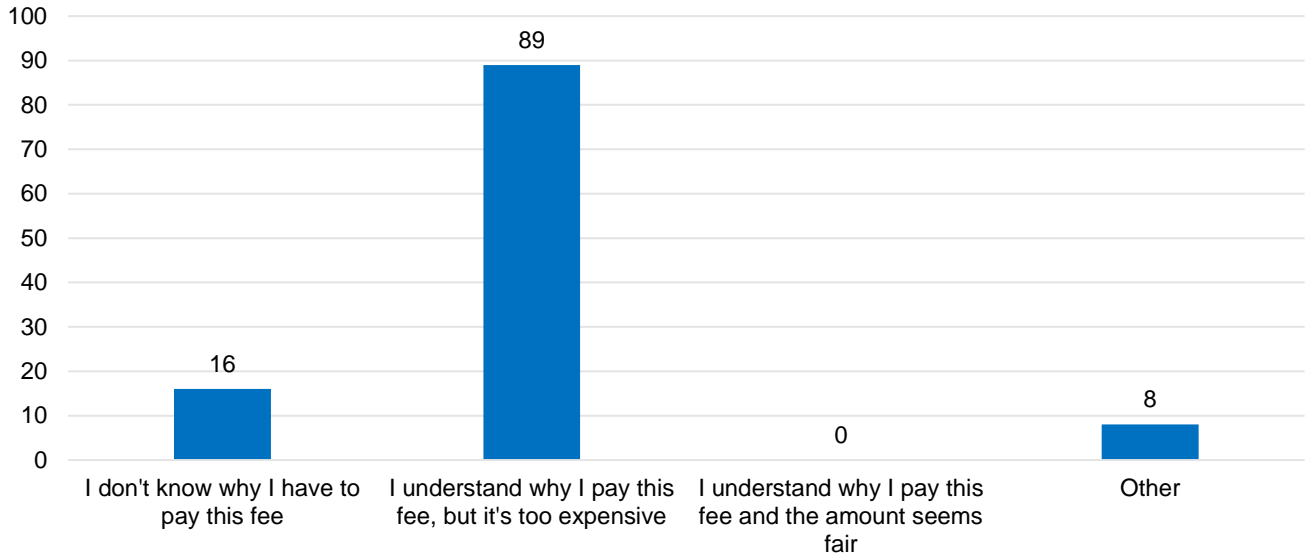
Importance of Sewer Infrastructure to Reduce Pollution

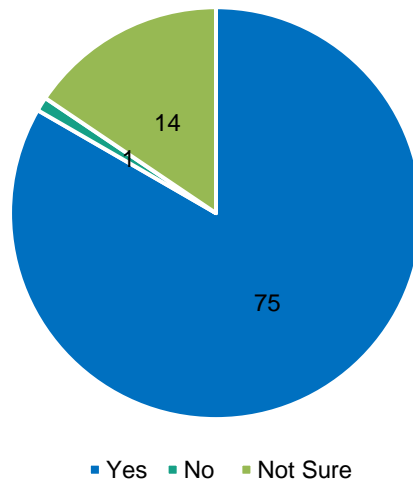
Feelings about Sanitary Sewer User Fees

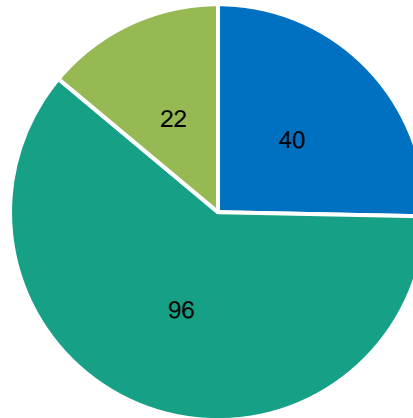
Aware of City's Consent Order?
